

Corporate Carbon Footprint (CFO) Policy

Chularat Hospital Public Company Limited and its subsidiaries (“the Company”) have established a Corporate Carbon Footprint Policy (Carbon Footprint for Organization: CFO) to systematically quantify and monitor the Company’s greenhouse gas emissions and removals. This policy serves as a framework to guide the Company in identifying opportunities for reducing greenhouse gas emissions, enhancing sustainability, and supporting long-term environmental stewardship.

1. Objective

The purpose of this policy is to identify and evaluate the risks and opportunities associated with the Company’s greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions arising from its operations and activities. This policy provides a structured framework for measuring, calculating, and reporting the Company’s GHG emissions, thereby facilitating the implementation of effective strategies to reduce emissions. Furthermore, it aims to promote employee awareness, understanding, and engagement in initiatives designed to minimize GHG emissions and mitigate the impacts of climate change.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all operational processes under the Company’s authority and control. It encompasses the assessment, monitoring, and quantification of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions resulting from the Company’s activities, in accordance with the Operational Control Approach.

3. Roles, Responsibilities, and Authority in Carbon Footprint

3.1 Employee Awareness and Engagement: The Company shall promote and support employee understanding of the impacts of climate change resulting from activities at both home and the workplace. This shall be achieved through annual training programs, workshops, and environmental conservation activities designed to raise awareness, foster a sense of responsibility, and encourage active participation in reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Initiatives may include energy conservation, efficient resource utilization, and collaborative team efforts, all aligned with the principles of a Green Hospital and Zero Waste.

3.2 Data Collection and Reporting: Employees in relevant functions are responsible for collecting data and supporting evidence related to greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and removals arising from the Company’s operational activities. This information shall be used to assess the effectiveness of the Company’s GHG management strategies and disclosed in the One Report Form 56-1 and the Sustainability Report.
